## Notice to Public Housing Applicants

The Wilmington Housing Authority's Public Housing Waiting List is closed. When we begin accepting applications, we will post in the local paper and/or our website and social media. We are truly sorry for any inconvenience this has caused you.

As per Wilmington Housing Authority's Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy, preferences are given to families that are:

- Employed defined as working a minimum of twenty (20) hours per week.
- Elderly, age of 62 years or older, handicapped or disabled.
- Displaced by a Presidentially declared natural disaster.
- Homeless.
- Youth aging out of foster care.

**Please be advised that we do not assign numbers. You are placed on our waiting list according to the date and time of your preliminary application.**

Therefore, to ensure accurate placement and to guarantee you receive correspondence from our office, it is imperative that you keep us updated of changes to your address, telephone number, income and/or family composition. Failure to update our office with address and phone number changes, will result in your name being removed from the waiting list.

All changes must be submitted in writing. These changes will be accepted on Tuesdays and/or Thursdays between the hours of 9 – 11 a.m. or 1-3 pm at Parkview Apartments, 1800 N. Broom Street, Wilmington, DE 19802. Please enter the building via the side entrance on the 18<sup>th</sup> Street side.

Wilmington Housing Authority is sensitive to the needs of our applicants; however, we do not have emergency housing and cannot determine the length of time before you may be housed.
