WHA EXPANDS PARTNERSHIP WITH NEW CASTLE COUNTY TO REMOVE HOUSING BARRIERS FOR HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER PARTICIPANTS

On February 15, 2023, Wilmington Housing Authority Executive Director, Ray Fitzgerald, and New Castle County Executive, Matt Meyer, signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to launch the Housing Choice Voucher Portability Pilot Program. The expanded partnership allows voucher holders to use their Housing Choice Vouchers (Section 8) in both jurisdictions without any additional paperwork or applications.

The program provides greater opportunities for people to not only obtain affordable housing, but also live in communities where they can thrive. "This is one great example of progress" stated Mayor of Wilmington, Mike Purzycki. Voucher holders will not only be able to live in areas closer to their jobs, schools, and other resources, but also live closer to their families and support systems.

The agreement also alleviates the administrative burden for landlords as well as WHA and New Castle County staff members. "We believe that the MOU signing, this expansion of our partnership with New Castle County, will go a long way to eliminate some of those burdens on the front-end for residents, voucher holders, and landlords," stated WHA Executive Director, Ray Fitzgerald.

Matt Meyer, New Castle County Executive, also states that "Hopefully this is one of many steps of the City and County working together so that when you work in government you don't see the border around the city that most people don't see anyway." The expanded partnership creates more opportunities for both agencies to support clients with housing as they build a better life for themselves and their families.

WHA is excited to celebrate this expanded partnership, and would like to thank New Castle County Executive, Matt Meyer, Mayor of Wilmington, Mike Purzycki, HUD Region 3 Administrator, Matt Heckles, for support of this partnership.

RENT REPORTING PILOT PROGRAM LAUNCHED

The Rent Reporting Pilot Program is a partnership between Delaware State Housing Authority (DSHA), Self-Financial, Inc., and NeighborGood Partners. This pilot is designed to help up to 400 low-income tenants build their credit through reporting on-time rent payments to the credit bureaus, and on-time utility payments to TransUnion credit bureau company.

Program funding is made available through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). Eligibility categories include, but are not limited to, tenants who have a housing voucher or live in public housing operated by one of the state's five public housing authorities (Delaware State Housing Authority (DSHA), Dover Housing Authority, Newark Housing Authority, New Castle County Housing Authority, and Wilmington Housing Authority).

FREE INFANT FORMULA DISTRIBUTION

Starting February 2, 2023, qualifying families with infants up to 12 months can receive one canister of formula at no cost to the family.

The State of Delaware, in partnership with Donate Delaware, purchased 44,000 canisters of Care infant formula.

To receive the formula, a family member must show proof that they are a Delaware resident. Examples of what to bring to show residency (you only need to bring one):

- A photo ID issued by the State of Delaware;
- A government-issued ID; OR
- A piece of printed mail or billing statement with a Delaware address.

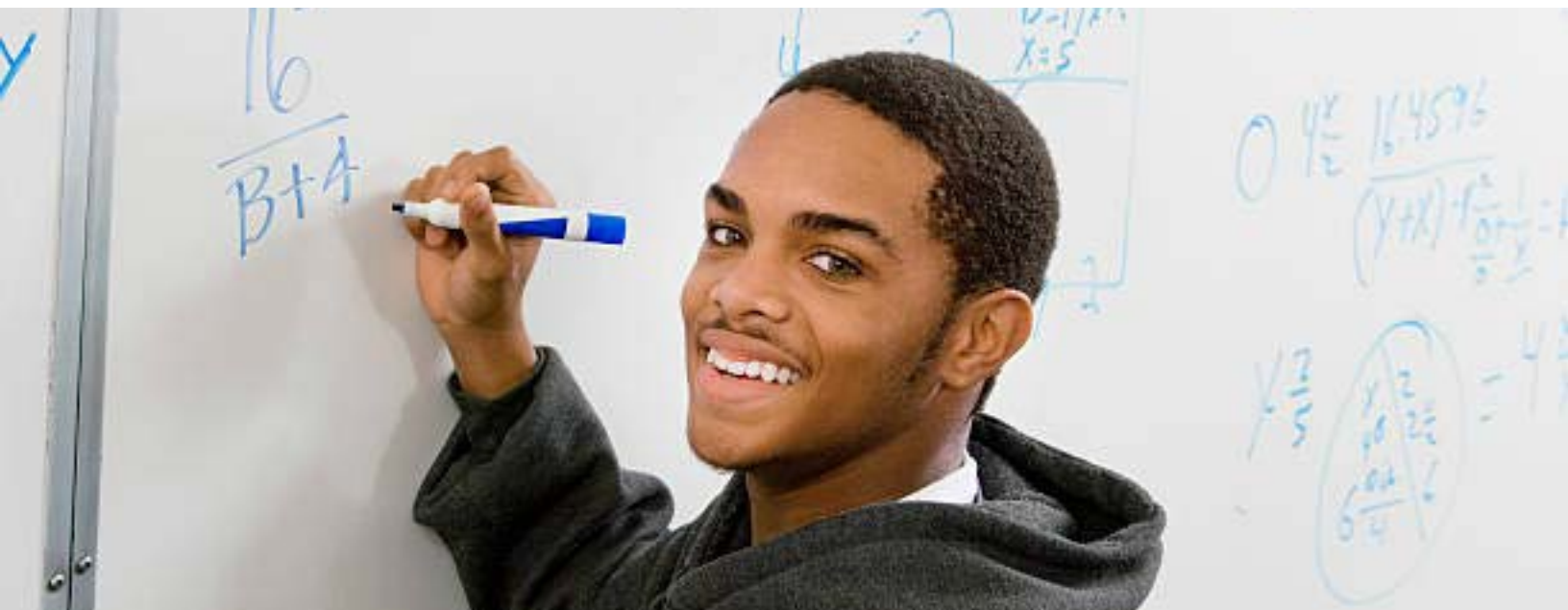

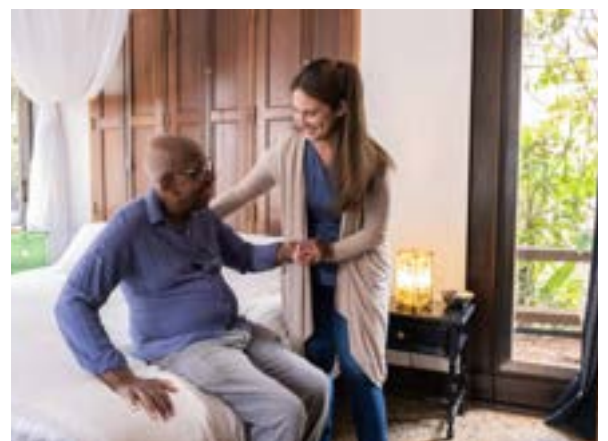

ANNUAL DELAWARE PARKS PASS ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

Delaware State Park entrance fee is charged daily from March 1st through November 30th. If you currently receive assistance from a State Service Center, you may be eligible to purchase one annual state park pass for \$10.00. Download the brochure or call (302) 739-9220 for more information about this special program.

Senior Lifetime Pass

For Delaware residents who are 65 years of age and over. The senior adult must be present in the vehicle when entering the park. You must show proof of eligibility to qualify. Lifetime passes may be purchased for the one-time cost of \$65.00 at any state park office.

America the Beautiful Access Pass

America the Beautiful Access passes are issued by the Department of the Interior. Passes are available to citizens or permanent residents of the United States who have been medically determined to be blind or permanently disabled and, as a result, are eligible to receive benefits under federal law. Delaware residents who hold an America the Beautiful Access Pass are exempted from paying seasonal or daily entrance fees to Delaware State Parks.

The America the Beautiful Access Pass can be purchased online at store.usgs.gov/access-pass, or at Alapocas Run, Bellevue, Killens Pond, and Cape Henlopen State Parks, as well as at Bombay Hook National Wildlife Refuges. For more information, visit destateparks.com.
