ATTEND THE WILMINGTON HOUSING AUTHORITY YOUTHBUILD INFORMATION SESSION

The YouthBuild program provides youth ages 16 to 24 that are not currently enrolled in high school and have not received a diploma with educational and credentialing opportunities, training in diverse industry areas (i.e. construction, information technology, green building, etc.), and leadership opportunities.

During this 3-6 month program, participants will work to obtain their GED, receive workforce training and credentials, and obtain hands-on experience in the fields of construction, information technology, green building, and more. Participants will also receive case management services and job placement support, with the goal matching each participant with long-term employment opportunities.

Wilmington Housing Authority is hosting three information sessions (two in-person, and one virtual) in July to learn more about the YouthBuild program and how to apply.


NAMI TRAINING PROGRAMS
